Enclosed please find the rules and regulations for the 2017 OPEIU Scholarships, specifically the John Kelly Labor Studies Scholarship, the Howard Coughlin Memorial Scholarship, and the Romeo Corbeil/Gilles Beauregard Summer Camp.

The deadlines for the John Kelly and Howard Coughlin Scholarships are March 31, 2017, and the Romeo Corbeil/Gilles Beauregard Summer Camp is May 15, 2017.

The OPEIU Scholarships are a great benefit for OPEIU members and their families. Please make sure this information is distributed to your members and publicize it in all workplaces.

ALL APPLICATIONS MUST BE SIGNED BY THE LOCAL PRESIDENT OR SECRETARY TREASURER BEFORE SUBMISSION. ANY APPLICATION THAT IS INCOMPLETE OR UNSIGNED WILL BE RETURNED TO THE LOCAL UNION OFFICE FOR FOLLOW UP WITH THE MEMBER/APPLICANT.

2017 - HOWARD COUGHLIN MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP FUND

ELIGIBILITY:

AN APPLICANT MUST BE EITHER:

- A member or an associate member of OPEIU in good standing on the date of award, unless a member loses employment to study on a full-time basis, has retired as a member in good standing, becomes disabled or terminated from employer layoffs and/or plant closing.
- The son, daughter, stepchild or legally adopted child of an OPEIU member in good standing or an associate member.
- High School senior or High School graduate entering a College, University or a recognized Technical or Vocational Post-Secondary School as a full-time or part-time student.
- Presently in a College, University, or a recognized Technical or Vocational Post-Secondary school as a full-time or part-time student.

FULL-TIME SCHOLARSHIPS:

Twelve (12) full-time scholarships will be awarded on the basis of at least one (1) per region. Applications are open to members in good standing, associate members, and their children, all of whom must meet the eligibility requirements and comply with the Rules and Regulations as established by the OPEIU Executive Board. Each scholarship award shall be granted with a payment of \$1,625.00 for each year of higher education with a maximum value of \$6,500.00, pending proof of enrollment.

PART-TIME SCHOLARSHIPS:

Seven (7) part-time scholarships will be awarded on the basis of at least one (1) per region. Part-time scholarships were implemented in order to reach a greater number of members, as full-time scholarships are generally awarded to children of members. Applications are open to members in good standing, associate members, or to their children, all of whom must meet the eligibility requirements and comply with the Rules and Regulations as established by the OPEIU Executive Board. Each scholarship award shall be granted with a payment of \$662.50 for each year of part-time higher education with a maximum value of \$2,650.00, pending proof of enrollment.

Part-time scholarships are defined as a minimum of three (3) credits and no more than two (2) courses. If a part-time student does not attend a college/university each semester, they have two (2) years maximum to use the part-time scholarship.

If the student becomes a full-time student, while receiving a part-time student scholarship, the scholarship will be revoked, and they will be able to apply for a full-time scholarship.

Part-time scholarship awards shall be subject to all other eligibility rules under this Scholarship Fund.

PROCEDURES:

Each applicant must file an official OPEIU scholarship application. Application forms must be endorsed by the Local Union President or Secretary-Treasurer attesting that a member, a parent or guardian of an applicant, or an associate member is in good standing on the date of award. Such endorsement must be obtained BEFORE the application is submitted. The application form must also be endorsed if a member loses employment to study on a full-time basis, retires, is disabled, or is terminated from employer layoffs and plant closings.

FORMS:

Application forms may be obtained at your Local Union office, at the Secretary-Treasurer's office of the International Union, or from our web site at www.opeiu.org. Once logged into the site, click on OPEIU Member Resources/OPEIU Membership Benefits link.

REQUIREMENTS:

All applications must be signed by the member's Local Union President or Secretary Treasurer before submittal to the International Secretary Treasurer's Office. Incomplete applications will be returned to the Local Office.

APPLICATION:

All completed applications are due in the International Secretary-Treasurer's office no later than March 31st.

SELECTION OF WINNERS:

All applications will be entered into a drawing and winners will be selected by region. All applicants will be notified in the month of May. Scholarship winners will receive a certificate and forms for completion in the mail. Applicants who have not been selected for an award will be notified by email.

OFFICE AND PROFESSIONAL EMPLOYEES INTERNATIONAL UNION 2017 - JOHN KELLY LABOR STUDIES SCHOLARSHIP FUND

ELIGIBILITY:

This scholarship is for **OPEIU MEMBERS ONLY**, which means, <u>dependents of OPEIU MEMBERS are NOT eligible to apply for this scholarship.</u> A member can only receive this scholarship once while seeking an undergraduate degree and once while seeking a graduate degree.

Ten (10) scholarships per year will be awarded on the basis of at least one (1) per region. Applications are open to members or associate members in good standing for at least two (2) years. All applicants must meet the eligibility requirements and comply with the Rules and Regulations as established by the OPEIU Executive Board. Each scholarship has a total maximum value of \$3,250.00.

THE APPLICANT MUST BE:

- a member or an associate member of OPEIU in good standing; and
- either an undergraduate or graduate in one of the following areas of study:
 - Labor Studies
 - Industrial Relations
 - Union Leadership and Administration
 - Programs sponsored by the National Labor College

PROCEDURES:

Each applicant must file an official John Kelly Labor Studies Scholarship application. **Application forms** must be endorsed by the Local Union President or Secretary-Treasurer attesting that the MEMBER or ASSOCIATE MEMBER is in good standing. Such endorsement must be obtained **BEFORE** the application is submitted.

FORMS:

Application forms may be obtained at your Local Union office, at the Secretary-Treasurer's office of the International Union, or from our web site at www.opeiu.org. Once logged into the site, click on OPEIU Member Resources/OPEIU Membership Benefits.

REQUIREMENTS:

Essay: All applicants shall be required to submit an essay on their union activism and

their occupational goals (300 to 500 words). This essay should be double-

spaced and typed on 8 1/2" x 11" paper.

College Transcript: If presently enrolled in a College, University or a recognized Technical or

Vocational Post-Secondary School, applicant is required to submit a college transcript. It does not have to be an official transcript; copies are acceptable.

Statement of Intent: All applicants shall be required to execute the Statement of Intent to remain

within the OPEIU for a period of at least two (2) years.

All applications, college transcripts (if applicable) and essays must be received at the Secretary-Treasurer's office of the International Union, 80 Eighth Avenue, Suite 610, New York, NY 10011, no later than **March 31**st.

SELECTION OF SCHOLARSHIP:

All applications will be entered into a drawing and winners will be selected by region. All applicants will be notified in the month of May. Scholarship winners will receive a certificate and forms for completion in the mail. Applicants who have not been selected for an award will be notified by email.
